

1. Validity of credits

Credits are valid only during the current dance season, i.e. from 1 September to 30 June.

Unused credits expire automatically at the end of the season.

They are neither refundable nor transferable to the following season.

This rule ensures straightforward administration and helps to keep prices affordable for everyone.

2. Use of credits

- 1 credit = 1 group class.
- Credits may be used freely for any classes corresponding to the participant's level.
- Credits may also be used for certain workshops or events, subject to the terms and conditions set out by Lékipdance (where applicable).

3. Booking

All class bookings must be made via Bsport.

A booking confirms the participant's place on the class.

4. Cancellation

A booking may be cancelled free of charge up to 6 hours before the start of the class.

After this time, the credit is considered to have been used.

This rule is in place out of respect for the teachers and other participants.

5. Absence

Any absence from a booked class, without cancellation within the specified timeframe, will result in the loss of the corresponding credit.

No refund will be granted.

6. Illness, accident or pregnancy

In the event of long-term illness, an accident, pregnancy or any other exceptional circumstance that permanently prevents the participant from practising dance, Lékipdance may, on an exceptional basis and upon presentation of supporting documentation, extend the validity of the credits.

This decision is at the sole discretion of the management.

7. Cancellation by Lékipdance

If Lékipdance cancels a class, the corresponding credit will automatically be credited back to the participant's account.

8. Force majeure

In the event of force majeure (pandemic, government decision, natural disaster, fire or any other event beyond Lékipdance's control), the management reserves the right to take the measures it deems most appropriate.

9. Levels

Credits grant access to classes corresponding to the participant's level.

The teaching team reserves the right to place a student in a different level in order to ensure the quality of the classes and optimal progress.

10. Conduct

Lékipdance reserves the right to refuse or exclude any participant whose behaviour jeopardises the smooth running of classes, respect for teachers or the safety of other participants.

In such cases, no refund will be issued.

11. Data protection

All registrations are managed via Bsport.

Personal data is processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

12. Personal nature of credits

Credits are strictly personal.

They may not be sold, transferred or exchanged with another person.

Our vision

Our credit system has been designed to offer maximum freedom whilst ensuring high-quality educational progression.

We encourage each participant to choose a Home Class for the season and to attend it regularly in order to make consistent progress.

At the same time, credits offer all the flexibility needed to:

- make up a missed class;
- explore other dance styles;
- take part in workshops or other activities organised by Lékipdance.

13. Minimum number of participants

Lékipdance reserves the right to cancel, combine or reschedule classes, series or workshops where the minimum number of participants is not met, or for any other organisational reason.

In such cases, the relevant credits will automatically be credited back to the participant's account.

14. Changes to teaching staff

Lékipdance reserves the right to replace a teacher or a pair of teachers in the event of absence, illness or for any organisational reason, without this entitling the participant to a refund or compensation.

15. Use of photos and videos

Photos and videos may be taken during classes, workshops and events organised by Lékipdance and used for communication and promotional purposes. Anyone who does not wish to appear in such material is asked to inform the organising team.
